### hiv / aids is a growing global pandemic

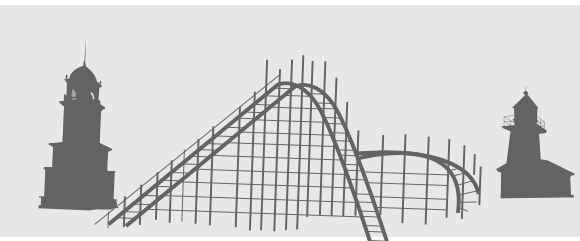
14,000 people are infected with hiv each day worldwide
